Choosing the right smart link platform can help you boost fan engagement, drive traffic, track data, and even monetize your content. This guide breaks down three of the top platforms used by indie musicians—Linktree, Hypeddit, and Koji.

Step 1: Know Your Needs

Are you promoting a single? Selling merch? Collecting emails? Your goals should determine which platform is best.

Step 2: Compare Platforms

- Linktree: Clean, reliable, widely used. Great for simplicity and brand look.

- Koji: Interactive options (tip jars, contests). Monetization is strong.

- Hypeddit: Music-focused tools for pre-saves, downloads, email capture.

Step 3: Optimize Your Link Page

Keep it clean, with only 3–5 links max. Add a headline that invites fans to engage. Use consistent branding (font, color, logo) and add your artist photo or banner.

Step 4: Use Analytics

Each platform gives you basic data. Monitor which links get clicks and adjust accordingly.

Pro Tip:

Use Bitly or a custom domain to shorten and brand your main smart link.
